## MyKCS - Carta Porte Instruction guide for Billing

For KCSM Carload and Intermodal Customers and KCS Customers exporting goods into Mexico:

Carta Porte is a mandated requirement for customers tendering traffic to/from Mexico and is issued by the Mexican Tax Authority (SAT). This industry requirement issued by the SAT applies to all cross-border shipments in and out of Mexico, as well as shipments within Mexico, via all modes including rail, road, sea, and air.

### On MyKCS we have 3 options to add the Carta Porte Information:

**Option 1:** Add the Carta Porte information when creating a new waybill: The patterns will have the Carta Porte information blank, but you will be able to add it as you work with your waybills.

**Option 2:** Add the Carta Porte information when creating a new waybill: The patterns will have the Carta Porte information blank, but you will be able to upload a file with the information with a Carta Porte template you can download and complete in Excel, this will be useful if you have a big list of cars/containers to bill.

**Option 3:** Add the Carta Porte information for your existing patterns: Clone your patterns to add the Carta Porte information and re-submit them for approval. You can delete the original patterns once the new ones are approved. When you are creating a new waybill, the Carta Porte Details will be pre-loaded.

### Carta Porte information includes:

- SAT Commodity Code and Description.
- Weight, Package Quantity & Type.
- Country of Origin.
- Tarif Rate Code.
- HAZMAT Code if applicable.
- MX HAZMAT Packing Code, if applicable.
- SAT MX Unit Packing Code.
- MX HAZMAT Packing Code, if applicable.
- MX HAZMAT Packing Code Description, if applicable.
- UUID per SAT Commodity Code.

### Effective on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, new fields will be required:

- Additional Role of Mexican IMPORTER, only for traffic going into Mexico.
- Mexican Importer's Tax ID (RFC) only for traffic going into Mexico.
- Mexican Material Type **for cross-border traffics**.

### Option 1 – Add the Carta Porte information when creating a new waybill.

Your Carta Porte information will be blank, but you will be able to add the information as follows:

When creating a Waybill, you will find below the General Information in the Equipment Selected List a new section will be shown to add or change the Importer information including the Tax ID (RFC), Only if the origin of your traffic is outside of Mexico and the car is going into Mexico.

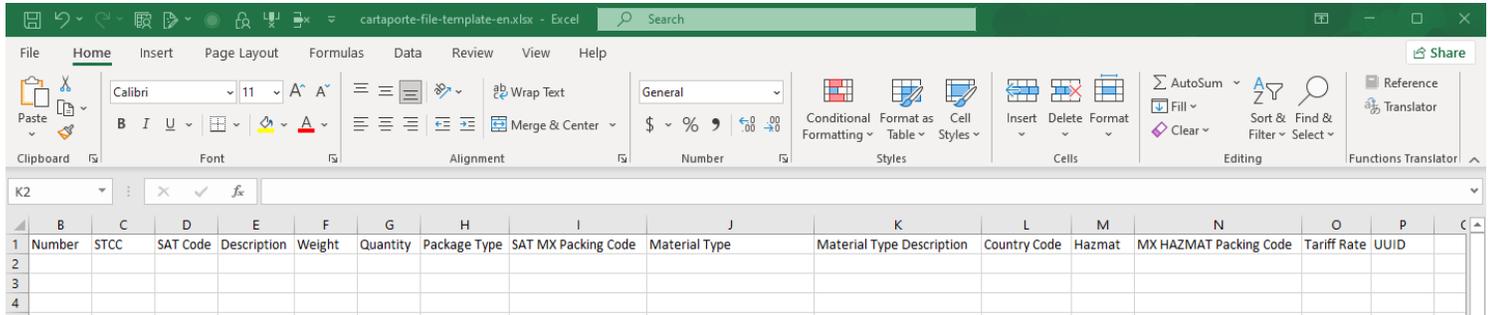

Fill in the required fields in the "cartaporte-file-template " tab:

- Enter the car/container's **Initial & Number**, one per line.
- Enter the **SAT Commodity Code** and the **Description**.
- Enter the **Weight, Package Quantity**.
- Select the **Package Type, SAT MX Unit Packing Code & Country of Origin** from the drop-down lists.
- Enter in the **HAZMAT Code** if applicable (if your STCC number starts with '49' (i.e. 4918125) then you must complete this field). If the commodity is not hazardous material, the system will mark this as an error.
- **MX HAZMAT Packing Code** – this field does *not* automatically populate, and the user must enter in the correct code that corresponds to the HAMZAT Code entered.
- **MX HAZMAT Packing Code Description** will be auto populated.

- Enter the **Tariff Rate Code** if your traffic is cross-border.
- Select the **Mexican Material Type** & the **Description Material Type** if your traffic is cross-border.

If a car/container has more than one SAT Commodity Code, you will have to add another line with the same car/container number with the information.

*Note: You can't use upload file if it is a multiwaybill.*

Once you have filled in the "cartaporte-file-template " tab, follow the instructions below to save the file in CSV format.

- Review the data entered in the "cartaporte-file-template " tab for accuracy. Updates can be made within the file before uploading or within MyKCS after uploading.
- Next, make sure that the "cartaporte-file-template " tab is selected. This step is important to correctly save the information entered in the template.
- Go to the "File" tab on the top ribbon.
- Select "Save as".
- Select "Browse", this will allow the file to be saved locally or in any selected folder.
- Once the browse window appears, select the "Save type as: CSV (comma delimited) (\*.csv)" option.

**Note: use the CSV type described above, as using any different CSV description will cause the information to load incorrectly.**

Example of formats NOT recognized

- CSV UTF-8(comma delimited) (\*.csv)
- CSV (Macintosh) (\*.csv)
- CSV (MS-DOS)(\*.csv)

- Select "Save" to save the file.

Note 1: After selecting "Save", Excel may display a message indicating that the selected format (csv) does not support documents with multiple sheets, in this case, select "Continue".

Note 2: "Save" will save the file in CSV format, which is necessary to be recognized in the upload process.

8. Continue completing your pattern creation as usual.
9. Re-submit to send the pattern through the approval process. Once approved, you can create your billing with the pre-loaded Carta Porte information.
10. If you clone a pattern with pre-loaded Carta Porte information, you can delete or change the information as needed.

*Note: The system has validations in place for all mandatory fields. If the codes are incomplete or entered incorrectly, the user will receive an error indicating the actions to be completed*

### Correct Waybill at MyKCS

To add or change the Carta Porte information to your billing go to Track and Trace on MyKCS landing page.

Select Waybill Inquiry and follow the instructions:

1. You can leave the filters blank and only change the waybill search date to match the waybill date you need to change. This will display all the waybills billed on the same date search.
2. Fill in the car/container Initial and number and change the waybill search date to match the waybill date on the car/container's billing date.

**Notes/FAQ's:**

1. For KCS Customers, these options will be available only if the Destination Station for the pattern/waybills is Mexico.
2. For empty cars or containers, the Carta Porte information is optional. For loaded cars or containers, the Carta Porte information is mandatory.
3. If the SAT code or other fields are filled in the Carta Porte details for empty cars or containers, an error will come up so all the other fields such as Tariff Code, weight, package quantity and type need to be filled in.
4. If the empty car or container needs the Carta Porte details, the weight must be 1, piece count 1.
5. The weight entered in the car billing will be copied for each car or container in the Carta Porte details.
6. For cars or containers with two or more SAT codes, the weight will be automatically copied to the first SAT code the car or container has.
7. The piece count and the package type will be copied from the billing to the first SAT code on the car or container.
8. If you do not click on the ADD CARTA PORTE DETAILS button, the system will mark it as an error and will not let you continue with the billing.
9. If MyKCS shows an error for the Carta Porte Information you must click on the MODIFY button in order to check and modify the details, to save the changes please click on ADD CARTA PORTE DETAILS button again.
10. If you have a pattern with the Carta Porte details pre-loaded, please click on the MODIFY button to add or check the information and then click on ADD CARTA PORTE DETAILS again to update the information. The editable information will appear above the Carta Porte current information.
11. If the pattern has the Carta Porte details pre-loaded and you click on ADD CARTA PORTE DETAILS, you will add a new SAT CODE duplicating the pre-loaded information. You can do this only if you need more than One SAT Code for your traffic.
12. If the car or container does not have hazardous material product, it is not necessary to add the HAZMAT code (the products that need this code are those where the STCC begins with 49 ex 4918125).
13. The tariff code, the country of origin, are mandatory only if the cars or containers are transiting out of Mexico. If the traffic is not an export move for KCSM, you Should not add these to the billing, the system will show this as an error, and you won't be able to continue with your billing.
14. The CFDI of international trade (UUID) is optional for export cars with a destination out of Mexico, check with your Mexican Customs Broker if you need this on your Carta Porte Details.
15. The CFDI of international trade (UUID) must not be included on waybills for cars from the USA or Canada with a Mexico destination.
16. Cars or containers billed at KCS with a Mexico destination must include all the Carta Porte Details: Sat Code, weight, piece count, package type and Tarif Code.
17. If you get an error for the **SAT Code at MyKCS**, please check the valid SAT codes on this link: [SAT Codes](#) look for the Catálogos de Complemento, when the file opens search for the **c\_ClaveProdServCP** tab.
18. If you don't find the **SAT MX Unit Packing Code** in the drop-down list is because it must match the Package Type list. MyKCS only has SAT MX Unit Packing Codes that match the Package Type list.
19. If you get an error for the **Tariff Rate Code**, please check it with your Mexican Customs broker.
20. If you get an error for the **MX HAZMAT Packing Code** at MyKCS, please check the valid codes on this link: [SAT Codes](#) look for the Catálogos de Complemento, when the file opens search for the **c\_TipoEmbalaje** tab.
21. The **SAT Code** must be 8 digits. Just numbers, no spaces and without decimals.

22. The **Tariff Code** must be 10 digits. Just numbers, no spaces and without decimals.
23. Weight should have no decimals.
24. Quantity of Package should have no decimals.
25. The HAZMAT Code must be 4 digits (the same as the UN/NA Number). Just the number without the letters.
26. The MX HAZMAT Packing Code is 3 alphanumerical digits.
27. Only 99 Sat Codes can be added to a waybill.
28. Mexico Material Type is ONLY for Cross-border shipments.
29. Mexican Importer is mandatory only for traffics with origin at US or Canada with Mexico as destination, not for Mexican Domestic traffic.
30. Importer Tax ID, Reference Guide is available [here](#).
31. Importer Tax ID must comply with the RFC guide.
